Tamorthiw Azrou

Chahine Berriche, Tunisia, documentary, 2022

Set in Azrou, a small Amazigh village in southern Tunisia, the film traces the historical and social changes of the village through several dwellers' testimonials collected over the last ten years. Azrou is not simply a mountainous village in the film but a collection of memories that links the past, present, and future of Tunisian Imazighen.
